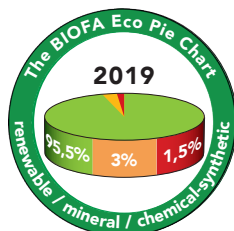
Properties:

BIOFA Patio Cleaner is a highly effective concentrate for quick and thorough but gentle cleaning. Removes green deposits and other soiling from patio surfaces, screens, garden furniture, pergolas, etc. made of untreated or oiled wood in outdoor areas. Also suitable for surfaces made of plastic and composite materials, as well as stone, concrete, exposed aggregate concrete, Eternit, roof tiles and paving slabs. It is not chemically preserved, is free from chlorine, ammonia and phosphates and is biodegradable.

For refreshing/treatment of already greyed surfaces, we recommend the use of BIOFA Entgrauer 2089!

Ingredients:

Water, 5-15% (soap potassium-ripened soya oil and coconut oil fatty acid), <5% non-ionic surfactant, cellulose, lavender oil (contains linalool), silver sulphate.



Directions for Use:

- 1. Pretreatment:** Brush off coarse dirt, if necessary clean the surfaces with a high-pressure cleaner first.
- 2. Processing:** Depending on the degree of soiling, dilute the concentrate with 2 to 3 parts water and apply evenly and generously to the dry surface using a brush, watering can or garden sprayer. Then spread with a brush, work well into grooves, cracks and corrugations and leave to work for at least 15-30 minutes. Then rinse well with clean water. In stubborn cases, repeat the process.

Important: The surfaces must be completely free of Terrace Cleaner and completely dry before any subsequent treatment with oil.

3. Post treatment and care: After-treatment and care of the wooden decking with BIOFA Decking Oil Art. No. 3753 restores fresh colour and protection to the wood.

Garden furniture is treated with BIOFA Teak Oil Art. No. 3752.

4. Equipment cleaning: Wash out with clear water immediately after use.



Recommended Equipment:



1. 009942 Flat brush 240 mm
2. 009973 Handle for surface brush and patio brush

Consumption/yield per coat:

Approx. 100-130 ml/m² (corresponds to 7-10m²/l) are applied per coat. However, consumption and coverage depend heavily on the type of application and the absorbency and condition of the substrate. 1 litre of Terrace Cleaner pure is sufficient for approx. 7-10 m². 1 litre of Terrace Cleaner diluted 1:3 (results in 4 litres) is sufficient for approx. 28-40 m².

Storage:

Store in a cool, frost-free and tightly closed place.

Container:

PE/PP plastic canisters

Disposal:

If possible, use up the product completely. Wash out soaked working materials thoroughly. Dispose of liquid product residues and containers that have not been completely emptied and cleaned in accordance with local/national regulations.

Only dispose of empty and cleaned containers for recycling.
